The Lord Chancellor and the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 10(1) of the Tribunals and Inquiries Act 1958(a), hereby make the following Order :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Tribunals and Inquiries (Commons Commissioners) Order 1970 and shall come into operation on 21st December 1970.

2. The Interpretation Act 1889(b) shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

3. Part I of Schedule 1 to the Tribunals and Inquiries Act 1958 shall have effect as if there were specified therein the Commons Commissioners and assessors appointed under section 17(2) and (3) of the Commons Registration Act 1965(c).
