BETTING AND GAMING**The Gaming (Small Charges) (Scotland) Order 1970**

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 40(2) of the Gaming Act 1968(a) and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I hereby make the following order:—

1.—(1) This order may be cited as the Gaming (Small Charges) (Scotland) Order 1970 and shall come into operation on 1st January 1971.

(2) The Interpretation Act 1889(b) shall apply for the interpretation of this order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

2. A sum of 1s. 0d. (5p) is hereby specified for the purposes of section 40(2) of the Gaming Act 1968 (which permits a sum of sixpence, or such other sum as may be specified by order, to be charged for the right of a person to take part, on any one day, in gaming to which section 40 applies).

This Order increases, from 6d. to 1s. 0d. (5p) a day, the charge which may be made in members' clubs and miners' welfare institutes for equal-chance gaming.
