The Juvenile Courts (London) (No. 2) Order 1970

16th December 1970 Made 1st January 1971 Coming into Operation

In exercise of the powers conferred upon me by paragraphs 14 and 20 of Schedule 2 to the Children and Young Persons Act 1933(a), as amended by section 17(1) of the Children and Young Persons Act 1963(b) read with section 12(1) of the Administration of Justice Act 1964(c), I hereby make the following Order:-

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Juvenile Courts (London) (No. 2) Order 1970 and shall come into operation on 1st January 1971.
- 2. In the Schedule to the Juvenile Courts (London) Order 1965(d), as amended (e) (which assigns divisions to juvenile courts in the metropolitan area and specifies the places of sitting of the courts), for the entry in column 2 relating to the place of sitting of a juvenile court for the West London (Kensington and Chelsea) division of the metropolitan area there shall be substituted the following entry:-

"163A Seymour Place, W.1."

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order amends the Juvenile Courts (London) Order 1965 by substituting 163A Seymour Place, W.1., as the place of sitting for a juvenile court for the West London (Kensington and Chelsea) division for the place of sitting at present specified in the Order, namely, 1A, Walton Street, S.W.3.
