**The National Health Service (Designation of Teaching
Hospitals) Amendment Order 1970**

Made - - - - - 16th March 1970
Coming into Operation 1st April 1970

The Secretary of State for Social Services, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by sections 11 and 75 of the National Health Service Act 1946(a) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, and after consultation with the Universities of Birmingham and of Manchester, hereby orders as follows:—

1. This order may be cited as the National Health Service (Designation of Teaching Hospitals) Amendment Order 1970, and shall come into operation on 1st April 1970.

2. The Interpretation Act 1889(b) shall apply to the interpretation of this order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

3.—(1) In Schedule 1 to the National Health Service (Designation of Teaching Hospitals) Order 1959(c) as amended(d) (which Schedule lists designated teaching hospitals) for the entry relating to the United Birmingham Hospitals there shall be substituted the following entry:—

(2) In column (2) of the said schedule for the words " St. Mary's Hospitals for Women & Children, Whitworth Park, Manchester (including St. Mary's Maternity Hospital, Whitworth Street West, Manchester) " against the name of the United Manchester Hospitals in column (1) there shall be substituted the words " St. Mary's Hospital, Whitworth Park, Manchester ".
