The Provision of Milk and Meals (Amendment No. 2)
Regulations 1970

The Secretary of State for Education and Science, in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 49 of the Education Act 1944(a) as amended by the Secretary of State for Education and Science Order 1964(b), section 3 of the Public Expenditure and Receipts Act 1968(c) and section 1 of the Education (School Milk) Act 1970(d), hereby makes the following regulations:—

Citation, commencement and interpretation

1.—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Provision of Milk and Meals (Amendment No. 2) Regulations 1970 and shall come into operation on 4th April 1970.

(2) The Interpretation Act 1889(e) shall apply for the interpretation of these regulations as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

Amendment of Regulations

2. At the end of regulation 4(1) of the Provision of Milk and Meals Regulations 1969(f) as amended (g) (provision of milk) there shall be added the words “and in every school which is designated as a secondary school under section 1 of the Education Act 1964(h)”.
