WAGES COUNCILS

The Wages Regulation (Retail Newsagency, Tobacco and Confectionery) (Scotland) (Amendment) Order 1970*Made* - - - 12th May 1970*Coming into Operation* 15th June 1970

Whereas the Secretary of State has received from the Retail Newsagency, Tobacco and Confectionery Trades Wages Council (Scotland) the wages regulation proposals set out in the Schedule hereto ;

Now, therefore, the Secretary of State in exercise of her powers under section 11 of the Wages Councils Act 1959(a), and of all other powers enabling her in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Wages Regulation (Retail Newsagency, Tobacco and Confectionery) (Scotland) (Amendment) Order 1970.

2.—(1) In this Order the expression “the specified date” means the 15th June 1970, provided that where, as respects any worker who is paid wages at intervals not exceeding seven days, that date does not correspond with the beginning of the period for which the wages are paid, the expression “the specified date” means, as respects that worker, the beginning of the next such period following that date.

(2) The Interpretation Act 1889(b) shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

3. The wages regulation proposals set out in the Schedule hereto shall have effect as from the specified date.

SCHEDULE

STATUTORY MINIMUM REMUNERATION

The Wages Regulation (Retail Newsagency, Tobacco and Confectionery) (Scotland) Order 1967(a) (Order R.N.T.S. (34)) shall have effect as if in the Schedule thereto:—

1. For paragraph 3 there were substituted the following paragraph:—

“WORKERS OTHER THAN MANAGERS AND MANAGERESSES

3. Subject to the provision of paragraph 1, the minimum remuneration payable to male or female workers (other than managers or manageresses) employed in Area 1 or Area 2, as the case may be, shall be the appropriate amount set out in the following tables:—

2. In paragraph 19 for the definition of 'Customary Holiday' there were substituted the following:—

“‘CUSTOMARY HOLIDAY’ means New Year’s Day (or, if New Year’s Day falls on a Sunday, the following day), the local Spring holiday, the local Autumn holiday and three other days, observed by local custom as holidays, to be fixed by the employer and notified to the worker; *and one other day (being a day on which the worker normally works) in the period commencing on 25th December and ending on the next following 8th January, to be fixed by the employer and notified to the worker not less than seven clear days before 25th December.*”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order, which has effect from 15th June 1970, amends the Wages Regulation (Retail Newsagency, Tobacco and Confectionery) (Scotland) Order 1967 (Order R.N.T.S. (34)) by increasing the statutory minimum remuneration fixed by that Order and providing for an additional day of customary holiday.
