**The National Health Service (Designation of London Teaching
Hospitals) Amendment Order 1970**

<i>Made</i>	- - -	23rd June 1970
<i>Coming into Operation</i>		1st July 1970

The Secretary of State for Social Services in exercise of his powers under sections 11 and 75 of the National Health Service Act 1946(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf and after consultation with the University of London, hereby orders as follows:—

1. This order may be cited as the National Health Service (Designation of London Teaching Hospitals) Amendment Order 1970, and shall come into operation on the 1st July 1970.

2.—(1) In this order—

“the Act” means the National Health Service Act 1946;

“the appointed day” means the 1st July 1970;

“the Board” means the Board of Governors of the London Hospital;

“the Committee” means the Brentwood Group Hospital Management Committee;

“the hospital” means the London Hospital Annexe, Brentwood, Essex.

(2) The Interpretation Act 1889(b), shall apply to the interpretation of this order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

3. In column 2 of the First Schedule to the National Health Service (Designation of London Teaching Hospitals) Order 1957(c), as amended (d), the words “the London Hospital Annexe, Brentwood, Essex” shall be deleted.

4. Any property immediately before the appointed day belonging to the Board and held solely for the purposes of the hospital shall on that day be transferred to the Committee.

5. Subject as aforesaid all right and liabilities to which the Board were entitled or subject immediately before the appointed day, being rights or liabilities acquired or incurred solely in respect of the hospital premises shall on that day be transferred to and vest in the Committee.
