

1971 No. 1680**FACTORIES****The Certificates of Appointment of Factory Inspectors Order 1971**

Made - - - 14th October 1971

Coming into Operation 22nd November 1971

The Secretary of State in exercise of his powers under section 150 of the Factories Act 1961(a) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:—

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Certificates of Appointment of Factory Inspectors Order 1971 and shall come into operation on 22nd November 1971.

(2) The Interpretation Act 1889(b) shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

2. The certificate of appointment to be furnished in pursuance of section 150 of the Factories Act 1961 to every inspector appointed under section 145 of that Act shall be in the form set out in the Schedule to this Order.

It is hereby certified that:
