The Apple and Pear Development Council (Amendment) Order 1971

Laid before Parliament in draft

Made - - - 25th March 1971

Coming into Operation

1st April 1971

The Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 8(1) of the Industrial Organisation and Development Act 1947(a) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, after consultation with the Apple and Pear Development Council (established under the said Act by the Apple and Pear Development Council Order 1966(b), as amended (c)), with the organisations appearing to him to be representative of substantial numbers of persons carrying on business in the industry and with the organisations representative of persons employed in the industry appearing to the Minister to be appropriate, hereby makes the following order a draft whereof has been laid before Parliament and approved by a resolution of each House of Parliament:—

Citation, commencement and interpretation

- 1.—(1) This order may be cited as the Apple and Pear Development Council (Amendment) Order 1971, and shall come into operation at the expiration of seven days beginning with the day on which it is made.
- (2) The Interpretation Act 1889(d) shall apply to the interpretation of this order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

Amendment of principal order

- 2. The Apple and Pear Development Council Order 1966, as amended, shall be further amended as follows:—
 - (a) by substituting in article 2 thereof for the definition of "grower" the following definition—
 - "'grower' means a person who carries on business in the industry and occupies land in England and Wales of five acres or more planted with 50 or more apple or pear trees;";

- (b) by deleting article 8 thereof;
- (c) by deleting from article 10 thereof the word "registered"; and
- (d) by deleting from article 13(1) thereof the words "not being exempt from registration".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This order further amends the Apple and Pear Development Council Order 1966, as amended, by making any grower, whether registered or not, who carries on business in the industry and occupies land in England and Wales of five acres or more planted with 50 or more apple or pear trees, liable to the annual charge which may be imposed by the Apple and Pear Development Council.
