The Health Services and Public Health Act 1968 (Commencement No. 5) (Scotland) Order 1971

Made - - - 25th March 1971

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 79(2) of the Health Services and Public Health Act 1968(a) and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I hereby make the following order :—

1. This order which shall extend to Scotland only, may be cited as the Health Services and Public Health Act 1968 (Commencement No. 5) (Scotland) Order 1971.

2. Section 13 (home help and laundry facilities) of the Health Services and Public Health Act 1968 and section 78(2) of and Schedule 4 to the said Act to the extent that section 28(1) and (2) of the National Health Service (Scotland) Act 1947(b) is repealed shall come into operation on 31st March 1971.
