The Import Duties (General) (No. 2) Order 1972

The Lords Commissioners of Her Majesty's Treasury, by virtue of the powers conferred on them by sections 1, 2 and 13 of the Import Duties Act 1958(a) and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, on the recommendation of the Secretary of State hereby make the following Order:—

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Import Duties (General) (No. 2) Order 1972.

(2) The Interpretation Act 1889(b) shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

(3) This Order shall come into operation on 3rd August 1972.

2. In Schedule 1 to the Import Duties (General) (No. 7) Order 1971(c) (which by reference to the Customs Tariff 1959 sets out the import duties chargeable under the Import Duties Act 1958) sub heading (A)(3)(a) of heading 33.01 (essential oils: not terpenaceous) shall be amended by omitting from sub-paragraph (i) the word "Citronella".
