**The Limited Partnerships (Amendment) Rules 1972***Made* - - - 10th July 1972*Coming into Operation* 1st August 1972

The Secretary of State, in exercise of his powers under section 17(a) of the Limited Partnerships Act 1907(a), and with the concurrence of the Treasury, hereby makes the following Rules:—

1.—(1) These Rules may be cited as the Limited Partnerships (Amendment) Rules 1972 and shall come into operation on 1st August 1972.

(2) The Interpretation Act 1889(b) shall apply for the interpretation of these Rules as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

2. In Rule 3 of the Limited Partnerships Rules 1907(c) paragraph (b) is hereby revoked.
