Milk and Meals (Education) (Scotland) Amendment

Regulations 1972

Made - - - - 7th August 1972

Laid before Parliament 15th August 1972

Coming into Operation 22nd August 1972

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by sections 53(3) and 144(5) of the Education (Scotland) Act 1962(a), and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I hereby make the following regulations:—

Citation, commencement and interpretation

1.—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Milk and Meals (Education) (Scotland) Amendment Regulations 1972 and these regulations and the Milk and Meals (Education) (Scotland) Regulations 1971(b) may be cited together as the Milk and Meals (Education) (Scotland) Regulations 1971 and 1972.

(2) These regulations shall come into operation on 22nd August 1972.

(3) The Interpretation Act 1889(c) shall apply for the interpretation of these regulations as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

Amendment of principal regulations

2. The Schedule to the Milk and Meals (Education) (Scotland) Regulations 1971 (determination of financial hardship) shall have effect subject to—

(a) the substitution for the table and first note of the following table and note—

- (a) £3·40 is to be added at each incremental point in every additional line;
 (b) £0·60 is to be subtracted at each incremental point in every additional column.”;

- (b) the addition in the second note after the word “rates” at the end of the definition of “net weekly income” of the following words—

“and disregarding any attendance allowance under section 4 of the National Insurance (Old persons’ and widows’ pensions and attendance allowance) Act 1970”.
