CUSTOMS AND EXCISE

The Anti-Dumping Duty (No. 2) Order 1972*Made* - - - - 7th September 1972*Laid before the
House of Commons* 13th September 1972*Coming into Operation* 14th September 1972

The Secretary of State, in exercise of his powers under section 1 of the Customs Duties (Dumping and Subsidies) Act 1969(a), hereby makes the following Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Anti-Dumping Duty (No. 2) Order 1972 and shall come into operation on 14th September 1972.

2. There shall be charged on the import into the United Kingdom of any goods of the description set out in the Schedule hereto (being goods classified in the Customs Tariff 1959(b) under the heading mentioned in the first column of that Schedule) a duty of customs at the rate mentioned in the third column.
