**The Hill Sheep Subsidy Payment (England and Wales)
Order 1972**

The Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food and the Secretary of State, acting jointly, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(3) of the Hill Farming Act 1946(a), as amended by section 8 of the Livestock Rearing Act 1951(b), and now vested in them jointly (c), and all their other enabling powers, with the approval of the Treasury, hereby make the following order:—

Citation and commencement

1. This order, which may be cited as the Hill Sheep Subsidy Payment (England and Wales) Order 1972, shall come into operation on 1st December 1972.

Interpretation

2.—(1) Unless the context otherwise requires, expressions used in this order have the same meaning as in the Hill Sheep (England and Wales) Scheme 1972(d).

(2) The Interpretation Act 1889(e) applies to the interpretation of this order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

Amount of subsidy payments

3.—(1) For the purposes of the Hill Sheep (England and Wales) Scheme 1972—

- (a) the basic rate of subsidy shall be £1·20 per ewe;
- (b) the supplementary rate of subsidy shall be £0·55 per ewe.

(2) Accordingly, subject to the provisions of that scheme, the amount which may be paid by way of subsidy payment in respect of an eligible ewe in relation to 1st December in the year 1972 and each of the four following years shall be—

- (a) if the ewe is comprised in a supplementary rate flock, £1·75;
- (b) if the ewe is comprised in any other qualified flock, £1·20.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the order.)

The Hill Sheep (England and Wales) Scheme 1972 sets out the conditions subject to which subsidy payments may be made to persons maintaining sheep on hill land. This order prescribes the amount of such payments for ewes comprised in flocks on 1st December in 1972 and the four following years. The payments vary according to the kind of sheep in the flock and the way in which the number of sheep in the flock is maintained.
