LEGAL AID AND ADVICE, ENGLAND
The Legal Advice (Amendment) Regulations 1972

Made - - - 14th November 1972

Laid before Parliament 24th November 1972

Coming into Operation 18th December 1972

The Lord Chancellor, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by sections 7 and 12 of the Legal Aid and Advice Act 1949(a), as amended by the Legal Aid Act 1960(b), hereby makes the following Regulations:—

1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Legal Advice (Amendment) Regulations 1972 and shall come into operation on 18th December 1972.

(2) The Interpretation Act 1889(c) shall apply to the interpretation of these Regulations as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

(3) In these Regulations a regulation referred to by number means a regulation so numbered in the Legal Advice Regulations 1959(d), as amended(e).

2. In regulation 3 (which relates to the financial conditions for legal advice) for the expression “£125” there shall be substituted the expression “£250”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)

The Regulations raise to £250 the amount of disposable capital which a person may have and be entitled to legal advice.
