Act of Sederunt (Rules of Court Amendment No. 4) 1972

Made - - - 28th November 1972

Coming into Operation 9th January 1973

The Lords of Council and Session under and by virtue of the powers conferred upon them by section 16 of the Administration of Justice (Scotland) Act 1933(a), section 13 of the Tribunals and Inquiries Act 1971(b) and of all other powers competent to them in that behalf, do hereby enact and declare as follows:—

1. The Rules of Court(c) are hereby amended as follows:—

- (1) Rule 291 is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of the words “Special cases under the Tribunals and Inquiries Act 1958, section 9(2)—(1) Special cases under the Tribunals and Inquiries Act 1958, section 9(2),” and by the substitution of the words “Special cases under the Tribunals and Inquiries Act 1971, section 13(2)—(1) Special cases under the Tribunals and Inquiries Act 1971, section 13(2),”.
- (2) Rule 292 is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of the words “Appeals under the Tribunals and Inquiries Act 1958, section 9(1),” and by the substitution of the words “Appeals under the Tribunals and Inquiries Act 1971, section 13(1)”.
- (3) Rule 293 is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of the words “Appeals under the Tribunals and Inquiries Act, section 9(5)” and by the substitution of the words “Appeals under the Tribunals and Inquiries Act 1971, section 13(5)”.

2. This Act of Sederunt may be cited as the Act of Sederunt (Rules of Court Amendment No. 4) 1972 and shall come into operation on 9th January 1973.

And the Lords appoint this Act of Sederunt to be inserted in the Books of Sederunt.
