**The Legal Aid in Criminal Cases (Complaints Tribunal)
(Amendment) Rules 1972***Made* - - - 14th December 1972*Coming into Operation* 1st January 1973

The Lord Chancellor, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 82 of the Criminal Justice Act 1967(a), hereby makes the following Rules:—

1.—(1) These Rules may be cited as the Legal Aid in Criminal Cases (Complaints Tribunal) (Amendment) Rules 1972 and shall come into operation on 1st January 1973.

(2) The Interpretation Act 1889(b) shall apply to the interpretation of these Rules as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

(3) In these Rules a form referred to by number means a form so numbered in the Legal Aid in Criminal Cases (Complaints Tribunal) Rules 1968(c).

2. In Form 6 for the words “the panels maintained under the Legal Aid Scheme 1950 or for such of them as the Tribunal think fit” there shall be substituted the words “acting for legally assisted persons”.

These Rules amend Form 6 of the Legal Aid in Criminal Cases (Complaints Tribunal) Rules 1968 so that a barrister may be given notice that an application has been made that he may be excluded from acting for legally assisted persons.
