EMERGENCY POWERS

The Electricity (Directions) No. 3 Order 1972

Made-

23rd February 1972

Coming into Operation

24th February 1972

The Secretary of State, in exercise of his powers under paragraphs (2) and (3) of Regulation 17 and paragraph (2) of Regulation 39 of the Emergency Regulations 1972(a) and of all other powers in that behalf enabling him, hereby orders as follows:-

- 1. This Order shall come into operation on 24th February 1972, and may be cited as the Electricity (Directions) No. 3 Order 1972.
- 2. This Order shall apply to all premises in relation to which Directions have been given by the Secretary of State under Regulation 17(2) of the Emergency Regulations 1972 and to all persons to whom such Directions have been given.
- 3. The Directions referred to in Article 2 of this Order shall in no case apply to the consumption of electricity for the operation of-
 - (a) any fan or other form of blower used in connection with a furnace or kiln fired by solid fuel, gas or oil; or
 - (b) any controlling mechanism for any such fan or other form of blower, or for the burners of any such furnace or kiln; or
 - (c) any other mechanism necessary for the operation of such burners.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order amends Directions given by the Secretary of State under Regulation 17(2) of the Emergency Regulations 1972 regulating or prohibiting the consumption of electricity.

It permits the consumption of electricity for the operation of fans and other forms of blower used in connection with furnaces and kilns fired by solid fuel, gas or oil, controlling mechanisms for such blowers and for the burners of such furnaces and kilns, and any other mechanism necessary for the operation of such burners.
