The Lord Chancellor, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 30(2) of the Solicitors Act 1965(a), hereby makes the following Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Solicitors Act 1965 (Commencement No. 4) Order 1972.

2. The following provisions of the Solicitors Act 1965 shall come into operation on 1st June 1972:—

sections 1 and 2;

Schedule 3, so far as it relates to section 54 of the Solicitors Act 1957(b);

Schedule 4, so far as it relates to sections 3(2) and 40 to 45 of the Solicitors Act 1957.
