The Beef Cow Subsidy Payment (Northern Ireland) Order 1972

The Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food, in pursuance of the powers conferred on him by subsections (4) and (7) of section 12 of the Agriculture Act 1967^(a) and of all his other enabling powers, with the approval of the Treasury, hereby makes the following order:—

Citation and commencement

1. This order, which may be cited as the Beef Cow Subsidy Payment (Northern Ireland) Order 1972, shall come into operation on 1st June 1972.

Interpretation

2.—(1) Unless the context otherwise requires, expressions used in this order have the same meanings as in the Beef Cow (Northern Ireland) Scheme 1972^(b).

(2) The Interpretation Act 1889^(c) applies to the interpretation of this order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

Amount of subsidy payment

3. Subject to the provisions of the Beef Cow (Northern Ireland) Scheme 1972, the amount which may be paid by way of subsidy payment under that scheme in respect of any eligible cow which on a prescribed date is comprised in a regular beef herd shall be £11.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

The Beef Cow (Northern Ireland) Scheme 1972 sets out the conditions subject to which subsidy payments may be made in respect of cows comprised in regular beef herds.

This order prescribes that the amount of such payments for 1972 and each of the four following years shall be £11 per cow.
