POLICE**The Police Cadets (Amendment) Regulations 1972**

Made - - - 4th May 1972

Laid before Parliament 12th May 1972

Coming into Operation 1st June 1972

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 35 of the Police Act 1964(a), and after consulting the Police Council for the United Kingdom in accordance with section 4(4) of the Police Act 1969(b), I hereby make the following Regulations:—

Citation, operation and effect

1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Police Cadets (Amendment) Regulations 1972 and shall come into operation on 1st June 1972.

(2) These Regulations shall have effect—

(a) except for the purposes of Regulation 4 thereof, as from the said date, and

(b) for the purposes of the said Regulation 4, as from 1st April 1972.

Interpretation

2. In these Regulations any reference to the principal Regulations is a reference to the Police Cadets Regulations 1968(c), as amended (d).

Uniform and equipment

3.—(1) At the beginning of Regulation 15(1) of the principal Regulations (uniform and equipment) there shall be inserted the words “Subject to paragraphs (1A) and (1B),”.

(2) After the said Regulation 15(1) there shall be inserted the following provisions:—

(a) 1964 c. 48.

(b) 1969 c. 63.

(c) S.I. 1968/25 (1968 I, p. 31).

(d) The relevant amending instrument is S.I. 1971/804 (1971 II, p. 2303).

“(1A) Where a police authority supplies a police cadet with footwear for the purposes of normal duty they shall supply 2 pairs of boots or shoes annually but, in lieu of supplying and providing for the repair of such footwear, they may pay a cadet an allowance at the rate of £0.24 a week.

(1B) Where, in the case of a woman, a police authority supplies a police cadet with stockings or tights for the purposes of duty they shall supply 18 pairs annually but, in lieu of supplying such pairs, they may pay a cadet an allowance at the rate of £9 a year.”.

Pay

4. For the Table in Schedule 1 to the principal Regulations (which, as set out in Regulation 4 of the Police Cadets (Amendment) (No. 2) Regulations 1971(a), contains scales of pay) there shall be substituted the following Table:—

Charge for board and lodging

5. For paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the principal Regulations (which, as set out in Regulation 5 of the said Regulations of 1971, relates to charges for board and lodging) there shall be substituted the following paragraph:—

“2. The annual rate of charge shall be—

(a) in the case of a police cadet attached to the City of London or metropolitan police force, £129;

(b) in any other case, £120.”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations amend the Police Cadets Regulations 1968.

Regulation 3 provides that a police cadet may be paid an allowance instead of being supplied with footwear and, in the case of women cadets, makes similar provision in relation to the supply of stockings or tights.

Regulation 4 increases the pay of a police cadet by amounts which vary according to his age. By virtue of Regulation 1(2)(b) (made in exercise of the power conferred by section 33(4), as applied by section 35(2), of the Police Act 1964), these increases have effect from 1st April 1972.

Regulation 5 increases charges payable by police cadets for board and lodging by £9 a year with effect from 1st June 1972.
