**The Road Vehicles (Excise) (Prescribed Particulars)
Regulations 1972**

The Secretary of State for the Environment in exercise of his powers under sections 12, 16, 23 (as modified by section 39(1) and paragraph 20 of Part I of Schedule 7) and 37 of the Vehicles (Excise) Act 1971^(a) and section 28(3) of the Furchase Tax Act 1963^(b), and of all other enabling powers, hereby makes the following Regulations:—

Commencement and citation

1. These Regulations shall come into operation on 28th June 1972, and may be cited as the Road Vehicles (Excise) (Prescribed Particulars) Regulations 1972.

Revocation, savings and transitional provisions

2.—(1) The Road Vehicles (Excise) (Prescribed Particulars) Regulations 1971(c) are hereby revoked.

(2) If any particulars are furnished or declaration is made before 15th July 1972 by a person applying for a licence under the Act, or who is required to make a declaration or furnish particulars, in a form prescribed by the Regulations hereby revoked, such particulars or declaration shall for the purposes of that application or requirement be deemed to be in a form prescribed by these Regulations.

Interpretation

3.—(1) In these Regulations, unless the context otherwise requires, the following expressions have the meanings hereby respectively assigned to them, that is to say:—

“the Act” means the Vehicles (Excise) Act 1971;

“form” means the appropriate form as set out in Schedule 2 to these Regulations;

“the Regulations of 1971” means the Road Vehicles (Registration and Licensing) Regulations 1971(a) as amended by the Road Vehicles (Registration and Licensing) (Amendment) Regulations 1971(b), and the expression “ownership” shall be construed as in those Regulations.

(2) Any reference in these Regulations to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended by any subsequent enactment.

(3) The Interpretation Act 1889(c) shall apply for the interpretation of these Regulations as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament, and as if for the purposes of section 38 of that Act these Regulations were an Act of Parliament and the Regulations revoked by Regulation 2 of these Regulations were Acts of Parliament thereby repealed.

Declaration and particulars

4. Subject to the following provisions of these Regulations on an application for a licence for a mechanically propelled vehicle of a description referred to in column (1) of Part I of Schedule 1 to these Regulations the declaration to be made and the particulars to be furnished shall be—

- (a) in the case of a vehicle for which a licence has not previously been issued, such declaration and such particulars contained in Form V55 as are specified in column (2) of that part of that Schedule in relation to a vehicle of that description;
- (b) in the case of a vehicle for which a licence has previously been issued, the declaration and particulars contained in the form referred to in column (3) of that part of that Schedule in relation to a vehicle of that description.

Declaration and particulars where licence has previously been issued and relevant circumstances have not changed or any change has been notified

5. Where a licence has previously been issued for a mechanically propelled vehicle and since the date on which the last licence for the vehicle was issued—

- (a) there has not been any alteration made to the vehicle or change in the use thereof so as in either case to bring the vehicle within a class or description which is one in relation to which duty payable under the Act falls to be determined and which is different from the class or description in relation to which duty on the vehicle was last paid, or to render payable under the Act duty at a rate different from the rate at which duty was last paid, and
- (b) in the case of an application made to a post office authorised for the time being to issue vehicle licences in accordance with arrangements made between the Post Office and the Secretary of State, there has not been any change of ownership, or, if there has been such a change of ownership, the relevant provisions of Regulation 12 (which relates to notification of change of ownership) of the Regulations of 1971 have been complied with,

the declaration to be made and the particulars to be furnished on the application for a licence for the vehicle shall be the declaration and particulars contained in Form VE.1A.

Seven day licences

6. On an application for a licence for any period of seven consecutive days in accordance with section 2(1)(c) of the Act for a vehicle to which that section applies the declaration to be made and the particulars to be furnished shall—

- (a) in the case of a vehicle for which a licence has not previously been issued, be such declaration and such particulars contained in Form V55 as are specified in column (2) of Part I of Schedule 1 to these Regulations in relation to the vehicles mentioned in paragraph 4 of Table A of Part II of Schedule 4 to the Act;
- (b) in the case of a vehicle for which a licence has previously been issued, be the declaration and particulars contained in Form VE.1B.

Trade licences

7. On an application for a trade licence in accordance with section 16 of the Act and Regulation 28 of the Regulations of 1971 the declaration to be made and the particulars to be furnished shall be the declaration and particulars contained in Form VE.7.

Invalid vehicles

8. The prescribed declaration and the prescribed particulars referred to in Regulation 26(2) of the Regulations of 1971 shall in relation to a mechanically propelled vehicle of a description referred to in column (1) of Part II of Schedule 1 to these Regulations be—

- (a) in the case of a vehicle for which a licence has not previously been issued, such declaration and such particulars contained in Form V55 as are specified in column (2) of that part of that Schedule in relation to a vehicle of that description;
- (b) in the case of a vehicle for which a licence has previously been issued, the declaration and particulars contained in Form VE.1/4.

Applications for more than six licences

9. Where application is made for licences for more than six mechanically propelled vehicles for each of which licences have previously been issued and the vehicles are of the same make and type, in the same ownership and subject to the same duty under the Act, the particulars to be furnished and the declaration to be made in respect of each of the vehicles may be the particulars and declaration contained in Form VE.6, if particulars are furnished and a declaration is made in respect of one of the vehicles on such of the forms referred to in column (3) of Part I of Schedule 1 to these Regulations as relates to the appropriate description of vehicle set out in column (1) of that part of that Schedule, or on Form VE.1A in the case where there has been no change of ownership of the vehicles since the date on which the last licences were issued, or, if there has been such a change of ownership, the relevant provisions of Regulation 12 (which relates to notification of change of ownership) of the Regulations of 1971 have been complied with.

Tramcars

10. On an application for a licence for a vehicle mentioned in paragraph 1 of Part II of Schedule 2 to the Act the declaration to be made and the particulars to be furnished shall be the declaration and particulars contained in Form VE.9.

Declaration of weight

11. The declaration of weight referred to in Regulation 45 of the Regulations of 1971 shall be the declaration specified in Form VE.12/9.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations revoke and replace the Road Vehicles (Excise) (Prescribed Particulars) Regulations 1971. They make new provisions with regard to the particulars required to be furnished and the declarations to be made upon applications for excise licences for mechanically propelled vehicles and upon the registration of exempt vehicles.

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
