FIRE SERVICES**The Fire Services (Appointments and Promotion) (Amendment)
Regulations 1972***Made* - - - 22nd June 1972*Laid before Parliament* 30th June 1972*Coming into Operation* 1st January 1973

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 18(1) of the Fire Services Act 1947(a), as amended by the Fire Services Act 1959(b), I hereby, after consultation with the Central Fire Brigades Advisory Council, make the following Regulations:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Fire Services (Appointments and Promotion) (Amendment) Regulations 1972 and shall come into operation on 1st January 1973.

2. For Part I of Schedule 1 to the Fire Services (Appointments and Promotion) Regulations 1965(c), as amended(d), (educational examination for promotion to the rank of leading fireman) there shall be substituted the following Part:—

“PART I*Educational examination*

A written examination in the following subjects, that is to say:—

- (a) mathematics, comprising the first four rules, weights and measures, decimals and vulgar fractions, simple squares and square roots, construction and interpretation of simple graphs and tables, areas and volumes and approximations;
- (b) English, comprising spelling, punctuation and handwriting; ability to write concise and factual English in letters and reports; comprehension and the composition of simple arguments based on given situations; and
- (c) general knowledge.”.

3. A member of a brigade who has passed, or is deemed to have passed, the examination specified in Part I of Schedule 1 to the said Regulations of

(d) The amending Regulations are not relevant to the subject matter of these Regulations.

1965 as originally made shall be deemed to have passed the examination specified in the said Part I as set out in the preceding Regulation.
