CUSTOMS AND EXCISE

**The Export of Goods (Control) (Amendment No. 3) Order
1972**

Made - - - - - 26th June 1972
Coming into Operation - 17th July 1972

The Secretary of State, in exercise of his powers under section 1 of the Import, Export and Customs Powers (Defence) Act 1939(a), hereby orders as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Export of Goods (Control) (Amendment No. 3) Order 1972 and shall come into operation on 17th July 1972.

2. The Interpretation Act 1889(b) shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament and as if this Order and the Order hereby revoked were Acts of Parliament.

3. The Export of Goods (Control) Order 1970(c), as amended (d), shall have effect as if in Group 5 of Schedule 1, the following was deleted, namely—

“ Coal, coke obtained from coal and solid fuels manufactured wholly or mainly from coal A ”.

4. The Export of Goods (Control) (Amendment No. 2) Order 1972 is hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order amends the Export of Goods (Control) Order 1970 by removing from control coal, coke obtained from coal and solid fuels manufactured wholly or mainly from coal.
