CUSTOMS AND EXCISE

The Export of Goods (Control) (Amendment No. 3) Order 1973

Made - - - 8th June 1973

Coming into Operation 1st July 1973

The Secretary of State, in exercise of powers conferred by section 1 of the Import, Export and Customs Powers (Defence) Act 1939(a) and now vested in him(b), hereby orders as follows:

1. This Order may be cited as the Export of Goods (Control) (Amendment No. 3) Order 1973 and shall come into operation on 1st July 1973.

2. The Interpretation Act 1889(c) shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament and as if this Order and the Orders hereby revoked were Acts of Parliament.

3. The Export of Goods (Control) Order 1970(d), as amended(e), shall have effect as if:

(a) in Article 5(1)(f) after the words "the said Schedule" the following was deleted namely:

"and (iii) goods falling within the entry relating to sugar in Group 8 of the said Schedule";

(b) in Group 8 of Schedule 1, the following was deleted, namely:

(i) "Potatoes A";

(ii) "Sugar, invert sugar and composite sugar products, qualifying for a distribution payment payable under section 14 of the Sugar Act 1956(f) A other than—

(a) goods produced or manufactured in the United Kingdom;

(b) goods exported as a single shipment or consignment in a quantity not exceeding 112 pounds or 10 gallons;

(c) goods exported by post;

(d) goods transhipped or exported from bonded warehouse;

(e) goods which were entered with the proper officer of Customs and Excise for home use or delivered from bonded warehouse for home use before 1st February 1972."
