**The National Health Service (General Medical and  
Pharmaceutical Services) (Scotland) Amendment Regulations  
1973**

*Coming into Operation* 1st August 1973

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by sections 34 and 40 of the National Health Service (Scotland) Act 1947(a) as amended(b) and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf I hereby make the following regulations:—

1.—(1) These regulations may be cited as the National Health Service (General Medical and Pharmaceutical Services) (Scotland) Amendment Regulations 1973 and shall come into operation on 1st August 1973.

(2) The Interpretation Act 1889(c) shall apply for the interpretation of these regulations as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

2. The National Health Service (General Medical and Pharmaceutical Services) (Scotland) Regulations 1966(d) as amended(e) shall be further amended as follows:—

In Part I of Schedule 3 (which part specifies the appliances to be supplied to persons receiving general medical services) there shall be inserted after the item “Colostomy apparatus: repairs and replacement only” the item “Contraceptive devices for women”.
