The National Insurance and Industrial Injuries (Collection of Contributions) Amendment Regulations 1973

The Secretary of State for Social Services(a), in exercise of powers conferred by section 12(7) of the National Insurance Act 1965(b) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, after considering the report of the National Insurance Advisory Committee on the preliminary draft submitted to them in accordance with section 108 of that Act, hereby makes the following regulations:—

Citation, interpretation and commencement

1. These regulations, which may be cited as the National Insurance and Industrial Injuries (Collection of Contributions) Amendment Regulations 1973, shall be read as one with the National Insurance and Industrial Injuries (Collection of Contributions) Regulations 1948(c), as amended(d) (hereinafter referred to as “the principal regulations”), and shall come into operation on 19th July 1973.

Amendment of the principal regulations

2. In regulation 6A of the principal regulations (recovery by employer of insured person's contributions during period when sale of stamps is interrupted) after the words “to the public” there shall be inserted the words “or the issue of insurance cards or emergency cards”.

Revocation of Provisional Regulations

3. The National Insurance and Industrial Injuries (Collection of Contributions) Amendment Provisional Regulations 1973(e) are hereby revoked, but without prejudice to anything duly done or suffered or to any right, privilege, obligation or liability acquired, accrued or incurred, thereunder.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations revoke and replace the National Insurance and Industrial Injuries (Collection of Contributions) Amendment Provisional Regulations 1973. They amend the National Insurance and Industrial Injuries (Collection of Contributions) Regulations 1948, as amended, by adding the non-availability of insurance cards or emergency cards to the circumstances in which paragraph (b) of the proviso to section 12(2) of the National Insurance Act 1965 (recovery by employer of insured person's flat-rate contribution) does not apply.

The report of the National Insurance Advisory Committee on the preliminary draft of these Regulations dated 14th May 1973 is contained in House of Commons Paper No. 337 (Session 1972-73) published by Her Majesty's Stationery Office.
