**MONOPOLIES AND MERGERS****The Restriction of Merger (Revocation) (No. 2) Order 1973**

The Secretary of State in exercise of powers conferred by section 10(6) of the Monopolies and Restrictive Practices (Inquiry and Control) Act 1948(a), as having effect by virtue of section 3(1) of the Monopolies and Mergers Act 1965(b), and now vested in him by virtue of the Transfer of Functions (Monopolies, Mergers and Restrictive Trade Practices) Order 1969(c), hereby orders as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Restriction of Merger (Revocation) (No. 2) Order 1973, and shall come into operation on 4th July 1973.

2. The Restriction of Merger (No. 1) Order 1973(d) is hereby revoked.

**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

*(This Note is not part of the Order.)*

This Order revokes the Restriction of Merger (No. 1) Order 1973. The Order which is revoked imposed a temporary standstill on any takeover of Capper-Neill Limited by Whessoe Limited while the Monopolies Commission inquired into the matter. The Secretary of State has consented under section 6(7) of the Monopolies and Mergers Act 1965 to the Monopolies Commission laying aside the reference on the grounds that the proposed merger has been abandoned.
