In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 44 of the Police Act 1964(a), and after consultation with the three Central Committees of the Police Federation for England and Wales sitting as a Joint Committee, I hereby make the following Regulations:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Police Federation (Transitory Provisions) Regulations 1973 and shall come into operation on 1st September 1973.

2. These Regulations shall be construed as one with the Police Federation Regulations 1969(b), as amended (c), but shall have effect notwithstanding anything in Regulations 6 and 12 of those Regulations (branch boards and central committees).

3.—(1) In the year 1973 no branch board elections shall be held in pursuance of paragraph (8) of the said Regulation 6.

(2) The members of branch boards serving as such on the date of the coming into operation of these Regulations shall, subject to paragraph (10) of the said Regulation 6, remain members thereof until 1st April 1974.

4.—(1) In the year 1974 no central committee elections shall be held in pursuance of paragraph (2) of the said Regulation 12.

(2) The members of each central committee serving as such at the beginning of the annual meeting in 1974 of the inspectors', sergeants' or, as the case may be, constables' central conference shall remain members of the committee in question as though they had been re-elected at that annual meeting.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)

Regulations 6 and 12 of the Police Federation Regulations 1969 provide for the election of members of branch boards and central committees of the Police Federation.

The present Regulations make transitory provision as respects the years 1973 and 1974. In 1973 no branch board, and in 1974 no central committee, elections are to be held. The serving members of branch boards are to remain members until 1st April 1974 (the date on which the Local Government Act 1972 becomes fully operative) and the serving members of central committees are to remain members as though re-elected in the year 1974.
