**POLICE****The Police (Amendment) (No. 3) Regulations 1973**

<i>Made</i> - - - -	1st August 1973
<i>Laid before Parliament</i>	10th August 1973
<i>Coming into Operation</i>	1st September 1973

In exercise of the powers conferred upon me by section 33 of the Police Act 1964<sup>(a)</sup> and after consulting the Police Council for the United Kingdom in accordance with section 4(4) of the Police Act 1969<sup>(b)</sup>, I hereby make the following Regulations:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Police (Amendment) (No. 3) Regulations 1973 and shall come into operation on 1st September 1973.

2. In these Regulations any reference to the principal Regulations is a reference to the Police Regulations 1971<sup>(c)</sup>, as amended<sup>(d)</sup>.

3. For Schedule 5 to the principal Regulations (pay) there shall be substituted the Schedule set out in Appendix 1 to these Regulations.

4.—(1) After paragraph 1 of Schedule 6 to the principal Regulations (detective duty and supplementary detective allowances) there shall be inserted the following paragraph:—

“(1A) The annual aggregate rate of pay and of detective duty allowance payable to a member of a police force holding the rank of superintendent shall not exceed by more than £250 what it would have been had the Police (Amendment) (No. 3) Regulations 1973 not been made; and where, in the case of such a member, the rate of detective duty allowance specified in paragraph 1 is not consistent with the foregoing provision, paragraph 1 shall have effect as if for the specified rate there were substituted such lower rate as is so consistent.”.

(2) For Tables A and B in the said Schedule 6 there shall be substituted the Tables set out in Appendix 2 to these Regulations.

## SCALES OF PAY FOR MEN

1.—(1) The annual pay of a man holding—

(a) a rank in the City of London or metropolitan police force referred to in the following Table A; or

(b) a rank in any other police force referred to in the following Table B, shall, subject as hereinafter provided, be determined in accordance with the appropriate scale set out in the Table in question.

(2) Except in the case of a member of the City of London or metropolitan police force and subject to sub-paragraph (3), for the purpose of determining the annual pay of a chief superintendent who had completed 1 or more years' service in that rank before 1st September 1972—

- (a) if he had completed only 1 year of service in that rank before that date, that completed year shall be disregarded;
- (b) if his completed years of service in the rank before that date were 2 or more, account shall be taken of 1 only of such completed years.

(3) Except in the case of such a member as aforesaid, the annual pay of a chief superintendent who on 1st September 1972 was assigned to duties designated for the purposes hereof by the Secretary of State shall be determined without regard to the provisions of sub-paragraph (2) but subject to the provisions of this sub-paragraph, that is to say—

- (a) if on the said date his old annual pay was £3,846 but he had less than a year's service in the rank, he shall be treated as if he had an additional year's service therein;
- (b) if on the said date his old annual pay was £3,975 but he had less than 2 years' service in the rank, he shall be treated as if he had completed 2 years' service on the date on which he completed a year's service therein;
- (c) if on both the said date and on 12th February 1973 his old annual pay was £4,101, his annual pay shall be £4,968;
- (d) if on 12th February 1973 his old annual pay was £4,230, his annual pay shall be £5,037.

For the purposes of this sub-paragraph "old annual pay" means annual pay determined as though the Police (Amendment) Regulations 1973 had not been made.

(4) In the case of a member of the City of London police force, the annual pay of a chief superintendent who held that rank in that force on 3rd October 1969 shall be £5,252.

2.—(1) The annual pay of a man holding the rank of superintendent shall, subject as hereinafter provided, be determined—

- (a) in the case of a member of the City of London or metropolitan police force, in accordance with the first and second columns of the following Table C:
- (b) in any other case, in accordance with the first and third columns of the following Table C.

(2) Except in the case of a member of the City of London or metropolitan police force and subject to sub-paragraphs (3) and (4), for the purpose of determining the annual pay of a superintendent who had completed 1 or more years' service in that rank before 1st September 1972—

- (a) if his completed years of service in that rank before that date did not exceed 2, the first such completed year shall be disregarded;

- (b) if his completed years of service in that rank before that date were 3 or more, account shall be taken of 2 only of such completed years.

(3) Where a superintendent has completed 4 or more years' service in the rank of chief inspector and the Secretary of State approves the application of this sub-paragraph in his case, his annual pay shall be determined without regard to the provisions of sub-paragraph (2) but subject to the provisions of this sub-paragraph, that is to say, his annual pay before completing 1 year's service in the rank of superintendent shall be—

- (a) in the case of a member of the City of London or metropolitan police force, £4,083 instead of £3,969;  
(b) in any other case, £3,759 instead of £3,645.

(4) Except in the case of a member of the City of London or metropolitan police force, the annual pay of a superintendent who, immediately before 1st September 1972, held the rank of superintendent, class 1, shall be determined without regard to sub-paragraph (2) but subject to the provisions of this sub-paragraph, that is to say—

- (a) if on 12th February 1973, he had not completed 3 years' service in the rank of superintendent, he shall be treated as if he had an additional 3 years' service therein;  
(b) if on the said date he had completed 3 or more years' service in that rank, his annual pay shall be £4,266.

3. -(1) The annual pay of a man holding the rank of constable shall, subject as hereinafter provided, be determined—

- (a) in the case of a member of the City of London or metropolitan police force, in accordance with the following Table D;  
(b) in any other case in accordance with the following Table E;

and any reference in this paragraph to the appropriate Table is a reference to Table D or Table E, as the case may require.

(2) The annual pay of a man holding the rank of constable shall be determined by reference to his reckonable service in accordance with the standard scale set out in the second column of the appropriate Table except that this sub-paragraph shall not apply where he was serving as a member of a police force immediately before 1st May 1971 and has so served continuously on and after that date; and in such case his annual pay shall be determined in accordance with sub-paragraph (3).

(3) Where sub-paragraph (2) does not apply, the annual pay of a man holding the rank of constable shall be determined by reference to his reckonable service in accordance with the transitional scale, appropriate to his age on the date on which he became a member of a police force, set out in the third, fourth, fifth or sixth column of the appropriate Table:

Provided that in a case in which the provisions of sub-paragraph (4) or of sub-paragraphs (5) and (6) apply, this sub-paragraph shall have effect subject to the provisions in question.

(4) The provisions of this sub-paragraph shall apply in the case of a man who has not served continuously as a member of a police force since he first became such a member and in such case the man shall be treated for the purposes of sub-paragraph (3) and the transitional scales set out in the appropriate Tables as if he had become a member of a police force on such date that, if he had served continuously as such a member, he would have the same reckonable service as he in fact has.

(5) The provisions of this sub-paragraph and of sub-paragraph (6) shall apply in the case of a man who has served continuously as a member of a police force since he first became such a member unless he is a man whose period of reckonable service began—

- (a) on a birthday;  
(b) after 1st March 1967, if he had attained the age of 22 years before his period of reckonable service began, or

(c) on or before 1st March 1967, if he had attained the age of 22 years on or before that date and—

(i) had not completed a year's or 2 or 3 years' reckonable service on a day in the year ending immediately before that date, being a day falling after his birthday in that year, or

(ii) had not completed a year's reckonable service or had completed 4 or more years' reckonable service on or before 1st March 1967;

and a man to whom this sub-paragraph applies who has had one or more birthdays falling within his period of reckonable service shall be treated for the purposes of sub-paragraph (3) and the transitional scales set out in the appropriate Table as if he had completed a year of such service on the date of his first birthday falling within that period.

(6) The annual pay of a man to whom sub-paragraph (5) applies who, by virtue thereof, is treated as having completed 2 years of reckonable service shall be restricted until he in fact completes 2 years of such service—

(a) if he had not attained the age of 21 years on or before the date on which he first became a member of a police force, to £1,562 where Table D applies or to £1,512 where Table E applies;

(b) subject as aforesaid, to £1,631 where Table D applies or to £1,581 where Table E applies.

(7) For the purposes of this paragraph—

(a) any reference to a man's reckonable service is a reference to his service reckonable for the purposes of his scale of pay;

(b) any reference to a man's birthday is a reference to an anniversary of the day of his birth, and

(c) in determining whether or not a man has served continuously as a member of a police force there shall be disregarded any break in service occurring on transfer from one police force to another or which ends with the man exercising a statutory right of reversion to his police force.

(2) Except in the case of a member of the City of London or metropolitan police force and subject to sub-paragraph (3), for the purpose of determining the annual pay of a chief superintendent who had completed 1 or more years' service in that rank before 1st September 1972—

- (a) if she had completed only 1 year of service in that rank before that date, that completed year shall be disregarded;
- (b) if her completed years of service in that rank before that date were 2 or more, account shall be taken of 1 only of such completed years.

(3) Except in the case of such a member as aforesaid, the annual pay of a chief superintendent who on 1st September 1972 was assigned to duties designated for the purposes hereof by the Secretary of State shall be determined without regard to the provisions of sub-paragraph (2) but subject to the provisions of this sub-paragraph, that is to say—

- (a) if on the said date her old annual pay was £3,462 but she had less than a year's service in the rank, she shall be treated as if she had an additional year's service therein;
- (b) if on the said date her old annual pay was £3,576 but she had less than 2 years' service in the rank, she shall be treated as if she had completed 2 years' service on the date on which she completed a year's service therein;
- (c) if on both the said date and on 12th February 1973 her old annual pay was £3,690, her annual pay shall be £4,722;
- (d) if on 12th February 1973 her old annual pay was £3,807, her annual pay shall be £4,791.

For the purposes of this sub-paragraph "old annual pay" means annual pay determined as though the Police (Amendment) Regulations 1973 had not been made.

2.—(1) The annual pay of a woman holding the rank of superintendent shall, subject as hereinafter provided, be determined—

- (a) in the case of a member of the City of London or metropolitan police force, in accordance with the first and second columns of the following Table C;
- (n) in any other case, in accordance with the first and third columns of the following Table C.

- (a) if her completed years of service in that rank before that date did not exceed 2, the first such completed year shall be disregarded;
- (b) if her completed years of service in that rank before that date were 3 or more, account shall be taken of 2 only of such completed years.

(3) Where a superintendent has completed 4 or more years' service in the rank of chief inspector and the Secretary of State approves the application of this sub-paragraph in her case, her annual pay shall be determined without regard to the provisions of sub-paragraph (2) but subject to the provisions of this sub-paragraph, that is to say, her annual pay before completing 1 year's service in the rank of superintendent shall be—

- (a) in the case of a member of the City of London or metropolitan police force, £3,879 instead of £3,771;
- (b) in any other case, £3,573 instead of £3,465.

(4) The annual pay of a superintendent who, immediately before 1st September 1972, held the rank of superintendent, class I, shall be determined without regard to sub-paragraph (2) but subject to the provisions of this sub-paragraph, that is to say—

- (a) in the case of a member of the City of London or metropolitan police force—
  - (i) if on 12th February 1973 she had not completed 2 years' service in the rank of superintendent, she shall be treated as if she had an additional 2 years' service therein;
  - (ii) if on the said date she had completed 2 or more years' service in that rank, her annual pay shall be £4,158;
- (b) in any other case—
  - (i) if on 12th February 1973 she had not completed 3 years' service in the rank of superintendent, she shall be treated as if she had an additional 3 years' service therein;
  - (ii) if on the said date she had completed 3 or more years' service in that rank, her annual pay shall be £4,056.

3.—(1) The annual pay of a woman holding the rank of constable shall, subject as hereinafter provided, be determined—

- (a) in the case of a member of the City of London or metropolitan police force, in accordance with the following Table D;
- (b) in any other case in accordance with the following Table E;

and any reference in this paragraph to the appropriate Table is a reference to Table D or Table E, as the case may require.

(2) The annual pay of a woman holding the rank of constable shall be determined by reference to her reckonable service in accordance with the standard scale set out in the second column of the appropriate Table except that this sub-paragraph shall not apply where she was serving as a member of a police force immediately before 1st May 1971 and has so served continuously on and after that date; and in such case her annual pay shall be determined in accordance with sub-paragraph (3).

(3) Where sub-paragraph (2) does not apply, the annual pay of a woman holding the rank of constable shall be determined by reference to her reckonable service in accordance with the transitional scale, appropriate to her age on the date on which she became a member of a police force, set out in the third, fourth, fifth or sixth column of the appropriate Table:

Provided that in a case in which the provisions of sub-paragraph (4) or of sub-paragraphs (5) and (6) apply, this sub-paragraph shall have effect subject to the provisions in question.



(4) The provisions of this sub-paragraph shall apply in the case of a woman who has not served continuously as a member of a police force since she first became such a member and in such case the woman shall be treated for the purposes of sub-paragraph (3) and the transitional scales set out in the appropriate Tables as if she had become a member of a police force on such date that, if she had served continuously as such a member, she would have the same reckonable service as she in fact has.

(5) The provisions of this sub-paragraph and of sub-paragraph (6) shall apply in the case of a woman who has served continuously as a member of a police force since she first became such a member unless she is a woman whose period of reckonable service began—

- (a) on a birthday;
- (b) after 1st March 1967, if she had attained the age of 22 years before her period of reckonable service began, or
- (c) on or before 1st March 1967, if she had attained the age of 22 years on or before that date and—
  - (i) had not completed a year's or 2 or 3 years' reckonable service on a day in the year ending immediately before that date, being a day falling after her birthday in that year, or
  - (ii) had not completed a year's reckonable service or had completed 4 or more years' reckonable service on or before 1st March 1967;

and a woman to whom this sub-paragraph applies who has had one or more birthdays falling within her period of reckonable service shall be treated for the purposes of sub-paragraph (3) and the transitional scales set out in the appropriate Table as if she had completed a year of such service on the date of her first birthday falling within that period.

(6) The annual pay of a woman to whom sub-paragraph (5) applies who, by virtue thereof, is treated as having completed 2 years of reckonable service shall be restricted until she in fact completes 2 years of such service—

- (a) if she had not attained the age of 21 years on or before the date on which she first became a member of a police force, to £1,490 where Table D applies or to £1,440 where Table E applies;
- (b) subject as aforesaid, to £1,556 where Table D applies or to £1,506 where Table E applies.

(7) For the purposes of this paragraph—

- (a) any reference to a woman's reckonable service is a reference to her service reckonable for the purposes of her scale of pay;
- (b) any reference to a woman's birthday is a reference to an anniversary of the day of her birth, and
- (c) in determining whether or not a woman has served continuously as a member of a police force there shall be disregarded any break in service occurring on transfer from one police force to another or which ends with the woman exercising a statutory right of reversion to her police force.
