**The Town and Country Planning Act 1971
(Commencement No. 20) (Doncaster, etc.) Order 1973**

Made - - - -

9th August 1973

The Secretary of State for the Environment in exercise of the power conferred on him by section 21 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971^(a) hereby makes the following order:—

1.—(1) This order may be cited as the Town and Country Planning Act 1971 (Commencement No. 20) (Doncaster, etc.) Order 1973.

(2) In this order:—

“the Act” means the Town and Country Planning Act 1971; and

“the Order area” means the area described in Schedule 1 to this order.

2. The provisions of the Act specified in the first column of Schedule 2 hereto (which relate to the matters specified in the second column of the said Schedule) shall come into operation in the Order area on 10th September 1973.

3. Pending the repeal of Part 1 of Schedule 5 and Schedule 6 to the Act as respects the Order area, any reference in the Act to the carrying out of a survey or preparation, approval, making or amendment of a development plan under the said Schedule 5 or to a plan or amendment approved or made thereunder shall be construed as respects the Order area as including a reference to the carrying out of a survey or the preparation, approval, adoption, making or amendment of a structure or local plan under Part II of the Act or, as the case may be, to a plan or amendment approved, adopted or made thereunder.

SCHEDULE 1

THE ORDER AREA

The county borough of Doncaster.

In the administrative county of Yorkshire, West Riding:—

The urban districts of Adwick-le-Street, Bentley-with-Arksey, Conisbrough, Mexborough and Tickhill;

The rural districts of Doncaster and Thorne.

In the administrative county of Nottinghamshire:—

In the rural district of East Retford:—

The whole of the parish of Finningley.

In the rural district of Worksop:—

In the parish of Harworth:—

The whole of the North Ward; so much of the East Ward as lies east and north of Ordnance Survey Parcels 4800, 4749, 5136 and 8630; and the detached part of the West Ward, which includes the hamlet of Hesley: all of which are more particularly delineated on the map annexed hereto and thereon hatched black.

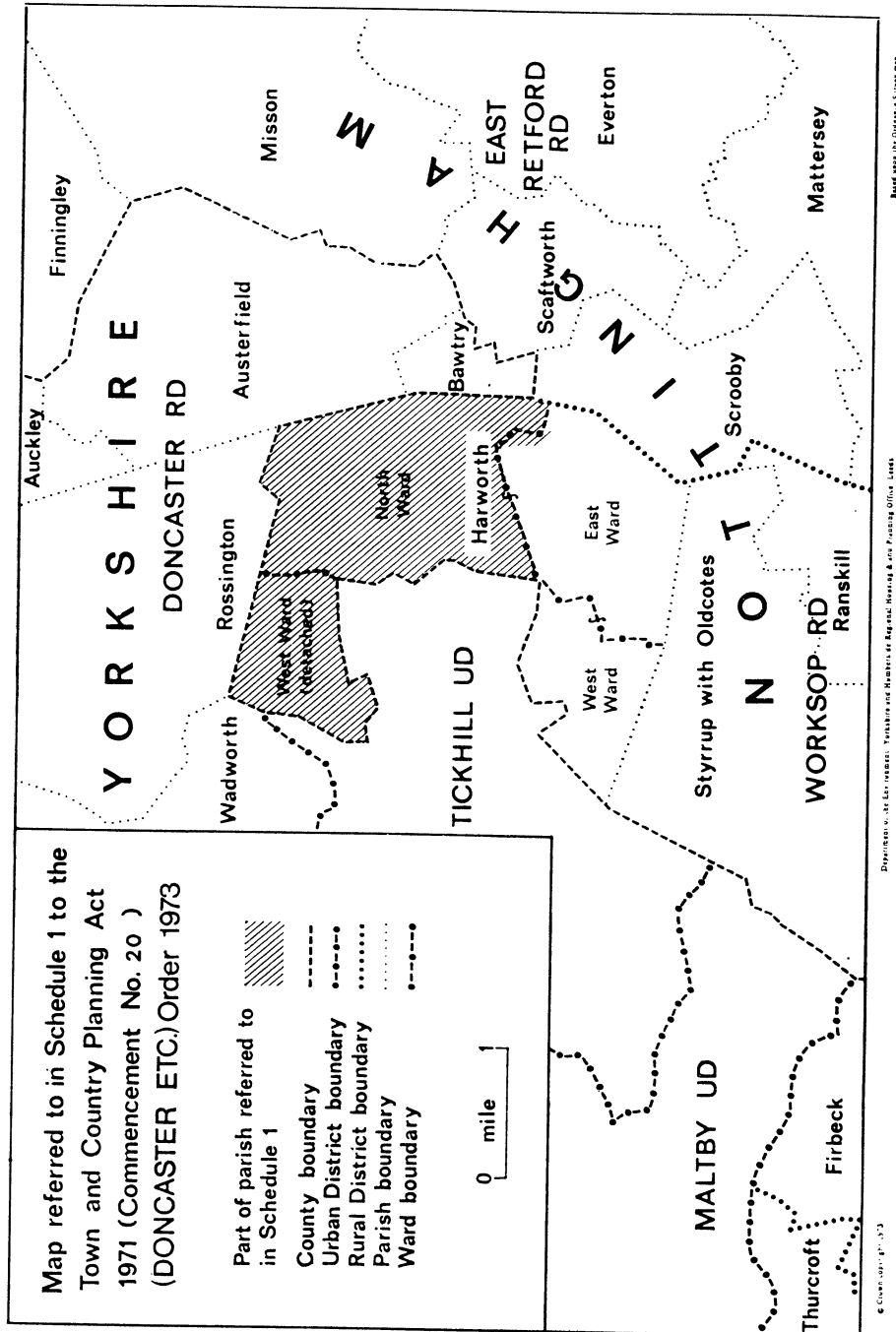
SCHEDULE 2

PROVISIONS COMING INTO OPERATION IN THE ORDER AREA ON 10TH SEPTEMBER 1973.

Part II, except sections 9(4), 18, 19, 20 and 21, and except so far as it enables any matter or thing to be prescribed.	New provisions as to development plans.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order brings into force for the county borough of Doncaster and certain adjacent areas in the administrative counties of Yorkshire, West Riding and Nottinghamshire, as described in Schedule 1 to the Order the provisions of Part II of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971 (as amended by sections 1, 2 and 3 of the Town and Country Planning (Amendment) Act 1972 (1972 c. 42)) which are set out in Schedule 2.

The provisions which are brought into force are the substantive provisions for the new development plan system of structure and local plans.

The provisions require a local planning authority to institute a survey, prepare a report of the survey and prepare and submit to the Secretary of State for his approval a structure plan for their area, and enable two or more local planning authorities, with the consent of the Secretary of State, to carry out their duties under Part II of the Act of 1971 by instituting a joint survey, preparing a joint report and preparing and submitting a joint structure plan for a combined area consisting of their areas or any part of their areas. The provisions also empower a local planning authority to prepare a local plan for any part of their area within the area of the structure plan.
