The Jurors' Allowances (Amendment No. 2)

Regulations 1973

Made - - - 19th September 1973

Coming into Operation 22nd October 1973

The Lord Chancellor, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 1 of the Juries Act 1949(a), as amended by section 1 of the Juries Act 1954(b), section 36 of the Courts Act 1971(c) and section 27 of the Criminal Justice Act 1972(d), and with the consent of the Minister for the Civil Service, hereby makes the following Regulations:—

1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Jurors' Allowances (Amendment No. 2) Regulations 1973 and shall come into operation on 22nd October 1973.

(2) In these Regulations "the principal Regulations" means the Jurors' Allowances Regulations 1972(e), as amended(f).

2. Regulation 4 of the principal Regulations shall be amended as follows:—

- (a) in paragraph 2(a), for the expression "57p" there shall be substituted the expression "62p";
- (b) in paragraph 2(b), for the expression "£1.25" there shall be substituted the expression "£1.35";
- (c) in paragraph 2(c), for the expression "£2.20" there shall be substituted the expression "£2.40";
- (d) in paragraph 2(d), for the expression "£3.12" there shall be substituted the expression "£3.40";
- (e) in paragraph 2(e), for the expression "£3.75" there shall be substituted the expression "£4.05"; and
- (f) in paragraph 3, for the expression "£8" there shall be substituted the expression "£8.65".

(f) There are no relevant amendments.

3. The Schedule to the principal Regulations shall be amended as follows:—

- (a) in paragraph 3(2), for the expression “2·6p” there shall be substituted the expression “2·7p”;
- (b) in paragraph 3(2)(i), for the expression “4·1p” there shall be substituted the expression “4·4p”;
- (c) in paragraph 3(2)(ii), for the expression “5·1p” there shall be substituted the expression “5·5p”; and
- (d) in paragraph 3(2)(iii), for the expression “5·6p” there shall be substituted the expression “6·0p”.
