**The Centec Centrifuge Techniques Limited (Designation)
Order 1973**

Made - - - 3rd January 1973

Coming into Operation 3rd January 1973

Whereas it appears to the Secretary of State that Centec Centrifuge Techniques Limited, being a company registered in England, has been formed pursuant to an agreement dated 4th March 1970 providing for collaboration in the development and exploitation of the gas centrifuge process for producing enriched uranium and made between Her Majesty's Government in the United Kingdom and the Governments of the Federal Republic of Germany and the Kingdom of the Netherlands:

Now, therefore, the Secretary of State, in exercise of his powers under section 19(2) of the Atomic Energy Authority Act 1971(a), and all other powers in that behalf enabling him, hereby orders as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Centec Centrifuge Techniques Limited (Designation) Order 1973.
2. Centec Centrifuge Techniques Limited is hereby designated for the purposes of section 19 of the Atomic Energy Authority Act 1971.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order designates Centec Centrifuge Techniques Limited for the purposes of section 19 of the Atomic Energy Authority Act 1971. That section provides that the security provisions in paragraphs 2 and 4 to 6 of Schedule 1 to the Nuclear Installations Act 1965 (c.57) (as set out in the Schedule to the Atomic Energy Authority Act 1971), shall apply in relation to a company so designated.
