WAGES COUNCILS

**The Hairdressing Undertakings Wages Council (Great Britain)
(Variation) Order 1973***Made* - - - 25th October 1973*Laid before Parliament* 5th November 1973*Coming into Operation* 29th November 1973

Whereas the Secretary of State has published in accordance with section 4(6) of, and Schedule 1 to, the Wages Councils Act 1959(a), notice of his intention to make an Order varying the field of operation of the Hairdressing Undertakings Wages Council (Great Britain):

And whereas no objections have been made to the draft of the said Order referred to in the said notice:

Now, therefore, the Secretary of State in exercise of powers conferred by section 4(2) of the Wages Councils Act 1959 and now vested in him(b) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf hereby makes the following Order:—

1. The field of operation of the Hairdressing Undertakings Wages Council (Great Britain) is hereby varied by the exclusion therefrom of workers employed in hairdressing undertakings in hotels who are so employed by British Transport Hotels Limited, which exclusion is set out in paragraph 2(c) of the Schedule to this Order and accordingly the said Wages Council shall operate only in relation to workers to whom the said Schedule applies and their employers.

2.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Hairdressing Undertakings Wages Council (Great Britain) (Variation) Order 1973 and shall come into operation on 29th November 1973.

(2) The Wages Council (Hairdressing Undertakings, Great Britain) Order 1947(c) shall have effect as if for the Schedule thereto there were substituted the Schedule to this Order.

(3) The Interpretation Act 1889(d) shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

SCHEDULE

Article 1

WORKERS TO WHOM THE ORDER APPLIES

1. Subject to the provisions of paragraph 2 hereof the workers to whom this Order applies are all workers employed in Great Britain in a hairdressing undertaking, in respect of their employment in such undertaking.

2. This Order does not apply to any of the following workers in respect of their employment in any of the following circumstances, that is to say

(a) workers who are employed exclusively as chiropodists;

or

(b) workers employed in a department of a hairdressing undertaking being a department which is wholly or mainly engaged in the retail sale of goods (other than hairdressers' sundries);

or

(c) workers employed in hairdressing undertakings in hotels who are so employed by British Transport Hotels Limited.

3. In this Order the following expressions have the meanings hereby assigned to them:—

“hairdressing undertaking” means an undertaking or any part of an undertaking which is wholly or mainly engaged in hairdressing, including operations incidental or ancillary thereto;

“hairdressing” includes the following operations performed on hair growing on the head, face or neck of a male or female person, that is to say, lathering, shaving, cutting, singeing, shampooing, waving, setting, dressing, tinting, dyeing, bleaching and similar operations.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

The Hairdressing Undertakings Wages Council (Great Britain) was established in 1947 under the Wages Councils Act 1945 (c.17). Its field of operation is defined in the Wages Council (Hairdressing Undertakings, Great Britain) Order 1947. The Council continued in existence under the Wages Councils Act 1959 by virtue of section 26 of, and Schedule 5 to, that Act.

This Order, which comes into operation on 29th November 1973, varies the field of operation of the Wages Council by excluding therefrom workers employed by British Transport Hotels Limited in hairdressing undertakings in hotels.
