The Legal Aid and Advice Act 1949 (Commencement No. 13)
Order 1973*Made* - - - *29th November 1973*

The Lord Chancellor, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 17(2) of the Legal Aid and Advice Act 1949(a), hereby makes the following Order:—

1.—(1) The Interpretation Act 1889(b) shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

(2) This Order may be cited as the Legal Aid and Advice Act 1949 (Commencement No. 13) Order 1973.

2. The provisions of Part I of the Legal Aid and Advice Act 1949 shall come into operation on 1st January 1974 for the purpose of making legal aid available in connection with proceedings in the Restrictive Practices Court under Part III of the Fair Trading Act 1973(c), and any proceedings in that Court in consequence of an order made, or undertaking given to the Court, under that Part of that Act.
