**The Goods Vehicles (Authorisation of International Journeys)
(Fees) Regulations 1973**

The Secretary of State for the Environment, with the consent of the Treasury, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 56(1) and (2) of the Finance Act 1973(a), and of all other enabling powers, hereby makes the following Regulations:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Goods Vehicles (Authorisation of International Journeys) (Fees) Regulations 1973 and shall come into operation on 13th December 1973.

2. —(1) In these Regulations—

“community authorisation” means an authorisation granted pursuant to Regulation No. 2829/72 dated 28th December 1972 of the Council of the European Communities (b);

“E.C.M.T. licence” means a licence issued pursuant to the scheme adopted by Resolution of the Council of Ministers of the European Conference of Ministers of Transport on 14th June 1973;

“journey permit” means a permit issued pursuant to an agreement or arrangement mentioned in column 1 of the Schedule to these Regulations under the provision or one of the provisions of the agreement or arrangement mentioned opposite thereto in column 2 of the Schedule and providing for a number of outward and return journeys stated in the permit;

“period permit” means a permit issued pursuant to an agreement or arrangement mentioned in column 1 of the Schedule to these Regulations under the provision or one of the provisions of the agreement or arrangement mentioned opposite thereto in column 2 of the Schedule and providing for an unlimited number of journeys during a period stated in the permit.

(2) The Interpretation Act 1889(c) shall apply for the interpretation of these Regulations as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

3. The fee payable on the issue of a community authorisation shall be—

- (a) if it is valid for a period of one year, £60, or
- (b) if it is valid for a period of less than one year, for each such period of three months or part thereof, £15.

4. The fee payable on the issue of a E.C.M.T. licence shall be—

- (a) if it is valid for a period of one year, £60, or
- (b) if it is valid for a period of less than one year, for each such period of three months or part thereof, £15.

5. The fee payable on the issue of a journey permit shall be £1.25 and the fee payable on the issue of a period permit shall be £25.

6. All fees received under these Regulations shall be paid into the Consolidated Fund.

- (a) other member states of the European Community,
- (b) other member countries of the European Conference of Ministers of Transport, and
- (c) certain states with whom bilateral arrangements or agreements have been concluded.
