**The Trade Descriptions (Indication of Origin)
(Exemptions No. 6) Directions 1973**

Made - - - 20th December 1973
Coming into Operation 29th December 1973

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 1(5) of the Trade Descriptions Act 1972(a), hereby gives the following Directions:—

1. These Directions may be cited as the Trade Descriptions (Indication of Origin) (Exemptions No. 6) Directions 1973, and shall come into operation on 29th December 1973.

2. Subsection (2) of section 1 of the Trade Descriptions Act 1972 shall be excluded in relation to goods of the following descriptions, that is to say—

- (a) parts for motor vehicles;
- (b) parts for agricultural, forestry, earth moving and land levelling vehicles;
- (c) parts for implements and machinery for use with any such vehicle as is described in (b) above;
- (d) parts for trailers.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Directions.)

These Directions exclude section 1(2) of the Trade Descriptions Act 1972 (which requires that a United Kingdom name or mark applied to imported goods be accompanied by an indication of the country of origin of those goods) in relation to parts for motor vehicles, and in relation to parts for agricultural, forestry, earth moving and land levelling vehicles and parts for implements and machinery for use with such vehicles, and also in relation to parts for trailers.
