The Import Duties (Temporary Exemptions) (No. 4) Order 1973

The Lords Commissioners of Her Majesty's Treasury, by virtue of the powers conferred on them by sections 3(6) and 13 of the Import Duties Act 1958(a), and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, on the recommendation of the Secretary of State(b), hereby make the following Order :—

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Import Duties (Temporary Exemptions) (No. 4) Order 1973.

(2) The Interpretation Act 1889(c), shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

(3) This Order shall come into operation on 28th February 1973.

2. The Import Duties (Temporary Exemptions) (No. 3) Order 1973(d) shall be amended by omitting from Schedule 1 thereto the reference to heading 29.30 of the Customs Tariff 1959 and the related reference to Diisocyanatotoluene, mixed isomers, containing not more than 70 per cent. by weight of 2,4-diisocyanatotoluene.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order)

This Order amends the Import Duties (Temporary Exemptions) (No.3) Order 1973 so as to prevent the coming into effect of an exemption from import duty in respect of diisocyanatotoluene, mixed isomers, containing not more than 70 per cent. by weight of 2,4 diisocyanatotoluene.
