**The Counter-Inflation (Temporary Provisions) Act 1972  
Extension Order 1973**

*Coming into Operation* - 24th January 1973

At the Court at Sandringham, the 19th day of January 1973

Present,

The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty in Council

Her Majesty, in exercise of the power conferred upon Her by section 1(2) of the Counter-Inflation (Temporary Provisions) Act 1972<sup>(a)</sup> is pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:—

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Counter-Inflation (Temporary Provisions) Act 1972 Extension Order 1973, and shall come into operation on 24th January 1973.

(2) The Interpretation Act 1889<sup>(b)</sup> shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

2. For the period of ninety days mentioned in section 1(1) of the Counter-Inflation (Temporary Provisions) Act 1972 there shall be substituted the period of one hundred and fifty days.

This Order extends the duration of the standstill imposed under section 2 of the Counter-Inflation (Temporary Provisions) Act 1972 for a further sixty days from the end of the original ninety-day period.
