**The Police Act 1964 (Modification of section 21) Order 1973**

<i>Made - - - -</i>	<i>27th April 1973</i>
<i>Laid before Parliament</i>	<i>8th May 1973</i>
<i>Coming into Operation</i>	<i>1st June 1973</i>

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 254 of the Local Government Act 1972(a), I hereby make the following Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Police Act 1964 (Modification of section 21) Order 1973 and shall come into operation on 1st June 1973.
2. References in this Order to the Act are references to the Police Act 1964(b), as amended by any subsequent enactment.
3. An amalgamation scheme expressed to come into full operation in 1st April 1974 may be approved or made under the Act notwithstanding that it does not make provision with respect to the matters mentioned in paragraphs (d) and (e) of section 21(3) of the Act (transfer of persons, property etc.) and, accordingly, the said section 21(3) shall have effect in relation to such an amalgamation scheme as if it authorised, but did not require, the making of provision with respect to the said matters.

 EXPLANATORY NOTE  
 (This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order modifies section 21(3) of the Police Act 1964 in its application to police amalgamation schemes which become fully operative on 1st April 1974 (the date on which the Local Government Act 1972 becomes fully operative).

It provides that a scheme need not make such provision relating to the transfer of persons, property etc. as is mentioned in section 21(3)(d) and (e) (such provision may be made under powers conferred by the Local Government Act 1972).
