**The Royal Navy Terms of Service (Amendment)
Regulations 1973**

<i>Made - - - -</i>	<i>16th May 1973</i>
<i>Laid before Parliament</i>	<i>24th May 1973</i>
<i>Coming into Operation</i>	<i>1st July 1973</i>

The Defence Council, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 2 of the Armed Forces Act 1966^(a) and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby make the following Regulations:—

Citation, Commencement and Interpretation

1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Royal Navy Terms of Service (Amendment) Regulations 1973 and shall come into operation on 1st July 1973.

(2) The Interpretation Act 1889^(b) shall apply to the interpretation of these Regulations as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

Competent Naval Authorities

2. The Royal Navy Terms of Service Regulations 1967^(c), as amended ^(d), shall have effect as though in the Schedule thereto, in Column 3, for the words “The Director General of Naval Manpower” there were substituted the words “The Director General of Naval Manpower and Training” and for the words “The Head of Naval Personnel Division 1, Ministry of Defence” there were substituted the words “The Head of Naval Personnel Division 2, Ministry of Defence”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)

The Royal Navy Terms of Service Regulations 1967 specify certain persons to be competent naval authorities, in addition to the Defence Council and the Admiralty Board, for the purposes of some of those Regulations. The present Regulations amend the names of those authorities in two respects. One of the authorities for the purpose of approving the continuance in service of a person in naval service is now known as the Director General of Naval Manpower and Training and the authority for the purpose of publishing and providing forms of consent and notices is now the Head of Naval Personnel, Division 2, in the Ministry of Defence.
