BUILDING SOCIETIES

The Building Societies (Fees) Regulations 1974

Made - - - 25th July 1974
Laid before Parliament 6th August 1974
Coming into Operation 2nd September 1974

The Chief Registrar of Friendly Societies, with the consent of the Treasury, pursuant to the powers conferred upon him by section 123(1) of the Building Societies Act 1962(a), and to all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Building Societies (Fees) Regulations 1974 and shall come into operation on 2nd September 1974.

2. The Building Societies (Forms and Fees) Regulations 1962(b) shall be amended by substituting for Schedule 2 thereto the following Schedule:—

For an award of the Central Office on a dispute	12.50
and if more than one hearing, or an adjournment, becomes necessary, then £6.25 more for every hearing after the first, and for every adjournment.	
For the appointment of an inspector, or calling of a special meeting	18.75
On an application for the right to obtain names and addresses from the register of members	2.50
For any approval, authorisation, exemption, consent or permission to be given by the Central Office or the Chief Registrar under the Building Societies Act 1962	12.50
For the registration or filing of any notice required by the Building Societies Act 1962 to be sent to the Central Office	1.25
For every document (except as otherwise provided) required to be signed by the Chief Registrar or by the Central Office or to bear the seal of the Central Office	1.25
For every inspection on the same day of documents in the custody of the Central Office relating to one and the same society ..	0.12
For a copy or extract of any document in the custody of the Central Office, not exceeding 216 words, 62p, and, if exceeding that number, 12p per folio of 72 words, in addition to the fee, if any, for the signature of the Chief Registrar or Central Office, or for the seal of the Central Office: provided that where a photocopy is supplied the fee charged therefor may be of an amount less than the fee payable on the basis of word content.	
For any document certified as a true copy of a document in the custody of the Central Office, where the copy so certified is not made by the Central Office, 31p for the examination of such copy, and if the copy exceeds 216 words, for every additional folio of 72 words, 6p (in addition to the fee for the signature of the Chief Registrar or Central Office, or for the seal of the Central Office).	

3. The Building Societies (Fees) Regulations 1971(a) are hereby revoked.
