**The Justices' Allowances (Amendment) (No. 2)
Regulations 1974**

In exercise of the powers conferred upon me by Part III of Schedule 1 to the Administration of Justice Act 1973(a), I hereby make the following Regulations:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Justices' Allowances (Amendment) (No. 2) Regulations 1974 and shall come into operation on 30th September 1974.

2. In Regulation 5 of the Justices' Allowances Regulations 1971(b), as amended (c), for the words "£2.75" and "£5.50" there shall be substituted the words "£3.35" and "£6.70" respectively.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations increase the maximum rates of financial loss allowances payable to justices of the peace. The new maximum rates are £6.70, if the time involved exceeds 4 hours in a 24 hour period, and £3.35 in other cases.
