The Food Subsidies (Conditions) (Flour) Order 1974

Made - - - 19th September 1974

Laid before Parliament 20th September 1974

Coming into Operation 14th October 1974

The Secretary of State, in exercise of powers conferred by paragraph 2(1) and (5) of the Schedule to the Prices Act 1974(a) and of all other powers enabling her in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:—

Citation, commencement and interpretation

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Food Subsidies (Conditions) (Flour) Order 1974 and shall come into operation on 14th October 1974.

(2) In this Order—

“the Act” means the Prices Act 1974;

“conditions notice” means a notice of any conditions specified in this Order and which is given under paragraph 2 of the Schedule to the Act;

“high extraction flour” means wheat flour of not less than 80 per cent extraction packed by the miller in 70 lb. packs;

“subsidy payment” means any payment made in respect of high extraction flour under a scheme at any time in operation under section 1 of the Act (which makes provision for the payment of food subsidies).

(3) The Interpretation Act 1889(b) shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

Conditions relating to high extraction flour

2. Any person—

(a) who claims or receives a subsidy payment; or

(b) to whom any high extraction flour is sold otherwise than by retail and to whom a conditions notice has been given;

shall observe the conditions specified in article 3.

3. The conditions referred to in article 2 are—

(a) a condition that, except in the course of business carried on not with a view to profit, the high extraction flour in question shall not be used for manufacture;

(b) a condition that the person shall make and shall retain for a period of not less than 2 years from the date when he receives a subsidy payment or from the date when he receives any high extraction flour to which a conditions notice relates, as the case may require, records showing the following particulars, that is to say—

- (i) particulars of the quantity of high extraction flour to which any conditions notice received by him relates, identifying the notice and specifying the person by whom it was given and the date when it was received;
- (ii) particulars of the quantity of high extraction flour sold by him and in respect of which he gives notice of the conditions specified in this article;
- (iii) particulars of the quantity of high extraction flour sold by him by retail;

and shall for the like period retain all such documents as are referred to in, or are required to vouch records of, the particulars specified in (i) and (ii).

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order prescribes conditions to be observed by claimants or recipients of subsidy relating to high extraction wheat flour and by subsequent owners of such flour to whom notice of the conditions is given.
