**1974 No. 1610****CUSTOMS AND EXCISE****The Import Duties (Quota Relief) (No. 6) (Amendment)  
Order 1974**

*Coming into Operation*       30th September 1974

*To be laid before the House of Commons*

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 5(1) and (4) of, and paragraph 8 of Schedule 3 to, the Import Duties Act 1958(a), as amended (b), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:

**1.**—(1) This Order may be cited as the Import Duties (Quota Relief) (No. 6) (Amendment) Order 1974 and shall come into operation on 30th September 1974.

(2) The Interpretation Act 1889(c) shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

**2.** The Import Duties (Quota Relief) (No. 6) Order 1974(d) shall be amended by the substitution for “30th September” in Article 2(1) and (2) of “15th November”.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This Note is not part of the Order.)*

This Order, which comes into operation on 30th September 1974, provides for the two tariff quotas of polyamide 6 continuous filament yarn falling within subheading 51.01A of the Customs Tariff Act 1959 and polyamide 6 monofilament falling within subheading 51.02A1 that were opened under the Import Duties (Quota Relief) (No. 6) Order 1974 to be extended until 15th November 1974.
