The Yorkshire Water Authority (Leeds)

(Extension of Operation of Byelaws) Order 1974

Made - - - - - 24th October 1974

Coming into Operation - 1st December 1974

The Secretary of State for the Environment, in exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to section 19 (6) of the Water Act 1945 (a) and now vested in him (b), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby orders as follows:—

1. This order may be cited as the Yorkshire Water Authority (Leeds) (Extension of Operation of Byelaws) Order 1974 and shall come into operation on 1st December 1974.

2. The byelaws made on 6th December 1963 by the lord mayor, aldermen and citizens of the city of Leeds acting by the council of that city under section 17 of the Water Act 1945, which byelaws would, by virtue of the Leeds Corporation (Extension of Operation of Byelaws) Order 1973 (c), remain in force until 5th December 1974, shall remain in force until 5th December 1975.
