The Housing (Scotland) Act 1974 (Commencement)

Order 1974

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 51(3) of the Housing (Scotland) Act 1974(a) and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I hereby make the following order:—

1. This order may be cited as the Housing (Scotland) Act 1974 (Commencement) Order 1974 and shall come into operation on 27th November 1974.

2.—(1) In this order “the Act” means the Housing (Scotland) Act 1974.

(2) The Interpretation Act 1889(b) shall apply for the interpretation of this order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

3. Except in so far as any provision of the Act otherwise provides, the Act shall come into operation on 27th November 1974.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

Section 51(3) of the Housing (Scotland) Act 1974 provides that, except in so far as any provision of the Act otherwise provides, the Act shall come into operation on such day as the Secretary of State may by Order made by statutory instrument appoint. This Order provides that subject to the above exception the Act shall come into operation on 27th November 1974.
