The Health and Safety Licensing Appeals (Hearings Procedure) Rules 1974

Interpretation

2.—(1) In these Rules—

"the 1974 Act" means he Health and Safety at Work etc. Act 1974;

"appeal" means n appeal under section 44(1) of the 1974 Act;

"appellant" means a person who has brought an appeal;

"appointed person" means he person appointed by the Secretary of State to hold the hearing and, when so directed by the Secretary of State, to determine the appeal;

"hearing" means hearing to which these Rules apply;

"licensing authority" means he authority against whose decision the appeal is brought;

"the parties" means he appellant and the licensing authority;

"the site" means he site to which the licence which is the subject of the appeal relates or would, if issued, relate.

(2) The Interpretation Act 1889 shall apply to the interpretation of these Rules as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
