RATING AND VALUATION

The Valuation Lists (Proposals for Alteration) Regulations 1974

Made - - - 23rd December 1974

Laid before Parliament 15th January 1975

Coming into Operation 5th February 1975

The Secretary of State for the Environment, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 69(5)(c) and 114 of the General Rate Act 1967(a) and now vested in him(b) and by section 2(2) of the Welsh Language Act 1967(c) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following regulations:—

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Valuation Lists (Proposals for Alteration) Regulations 1974 and shall come into operation on 5th February 1975.
- 2.—(1) The Interpretation Act 1889(d) shall apply for the interpretation of these regulations as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- (2) In these regulations "proposal" means a proposal or a further proposal for the alteration of a valuation list made under section 69(1) or (3) of the General Rate Act 1967 as enacted or as extended by section 69(4) of that Act.
- 3. Subject to regulation 4 below every proposal shall be in the form set out in Schedule 1 to these regulations or in a form substantially to the like effect.
- 4. The form set out in Schedule 2 to these regulations is hereby prescribed as a version of the form of proposal partly in Welsh and partly in English and that form, or a form substantially to the like effect, may be used in place of the form set out in Schedule 1 to these regulations where the proposal is in respect of a hereditament situated in Wales.
- 5. The Valuation Lists (Proposals for Alteration) Regulations 1963(e) are hereby revoked.
